Swedetown Bridge Replacement

Project Location: Swedetown Bridge Replacement at M.P. 60.5 and US 30 from Van Street and east to the Swedetown Bridge

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Total Estimated Project Cost: Scoping needs to be done (\$3 million preliminary estimate)

Funding proposed: \$3 million

Project Description: The project will replace the existing two-lane bridge with a three-lane structure and functional underpass. The vertical clearance and turning area for trucks moving through the underpass will be corrected to modern standards for traffic that accesses the Port Westward Industrial Site via Swedetown Road and NE 5th Street. Increasing the structure to three-lanes will eliminate a “bottleneck” on the east side of the City on US Hwy 30 from Van Street through the Swedetown overpass.

Eligibility: Modernization projects may be eligible for funding if they are consistent with the applicable acknowledged transportation system plan (TSP) or, in the absence of an applicable acknowledged TSP, the applicable acknowledged comprehensive plan and any applicable adopted TSP. While reference to this improvement is found in the Portland-Astoria (US30) Corridor Plan (Projects 112, 159 and 210), it is necessary for the City to add this project to their TSP in order to fulfill the eligibility criteria.
